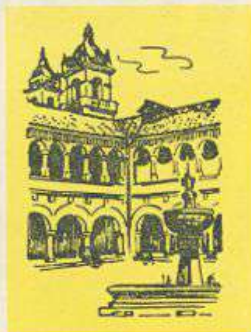

Visit to a hand-craft shop, if desired.



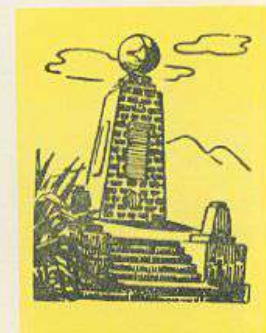

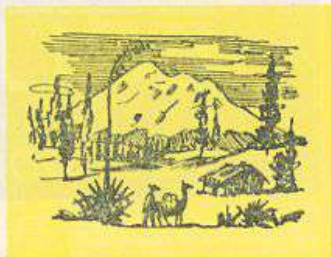

PUJILI (wednesdays only)

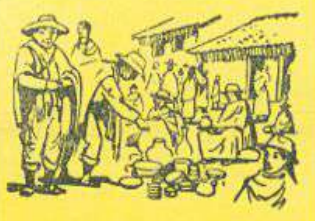

LATACUNGA MARKET TOUR (saturdays only)



Right by the beautiful Cutuche River we find the market, as the meeting place of the whole population of the surroundings, Indians (over 18.000) of different tribes, that trade and bargain mostly among themselves. Lunch at the Municipal Hotel. In the afternoon, short drive to an artificial lagoon and back to Quito, with volcanos and snow peaks from side to side.

To the Colorado Indians Territory

2 days

Leaving Quito early in the morning we drive to an altitude of some 12.000 feet, from which point we begin to descend to Santo Domingo de los Colorados (located at about 1700 feet) as our car winds its way down this western face of the Andes, we observe a constantly changing scene of vegetation, from the stunted growth of high uplands (paramos) to the luxuriant tropical world of bamboos, tree ferns and Blue Morpho butterflies. Overnight stay in a very nice and comfortable Hotel. Next day, visit to the Colorado Indians homes, who paint their hair and bodies using a paste from the achiote bean.

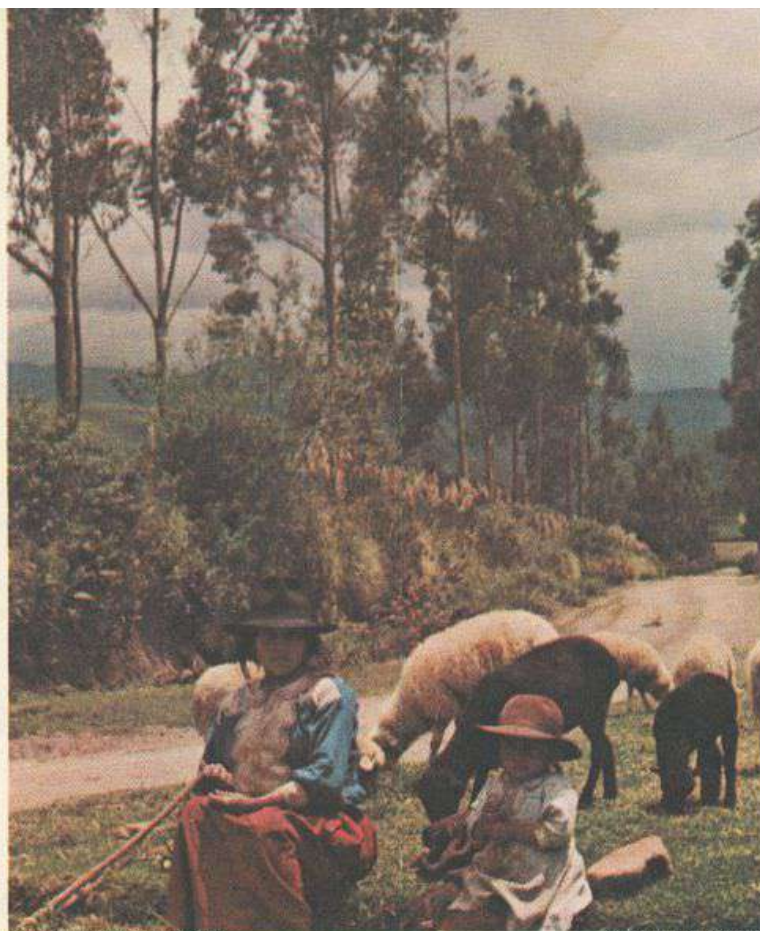

Leaving Quito on Friday, right after lunch, or earlier if so decided, the car will go through a well kept cobbled stone road, winding like a ribbon around the many hills, dips, and valleys for over three hours, with stops in several villages on the way, emphasizing on the one made at the Equatorial Line mark, before getting to the town of Cayambe that sits on the shadow of one of the most beautiful snow covered peaks in Ecuador. Once, at the end of the way, an overnight stay at a very comfortable hotel is offered, in the town of Ibarra, with a short sightseeing trip around the city and to an imposing lake, not far from it.

On Saturday, there will be an early start (5:30 a. m.) to Otavalo for a thirty minutes ride, where the marketing will be at full swing, visiting the two squares and the park. Then on the way to Quito, a short detour will be made to get a sight of another beautiful lake and resort Hotel with boating and skiing facilities. Arrival at Quito about 2:00 in the afternoon.
